Thank you for your interest in Bozeman Summit School. Bozeman Summit School is a non-profit, private early childhood and elementary school serving children three through twelve years of age. Since 1997, we've been educating some of Bozeman's brightest students in an environment that encourages academic excellence and a life-long passion for learning through individualized attention to each child's unique abilities and needs. Children flourish with low student/teacher ratios, small classroom sizes and a safe and caring environment. High-quality teachers provide "tools for life" with a challenging and creative curriculum based on proven Montessori principles of exploration, discovery, development and achievement.

The school offers an Early Childhood classroom, a Lower Elementary classroom and an Upper Elementary classroom. The Early Childhood class includes children ages three through six (including the kindergarten year), the Lower Elementary class includes children ages six through nine (first, second and third grades) while the Upper Elementary Class includes ages nine through twelve (fourth, fifth and sixth grades). This configuration is aligned with the Montessori teaching method and developmental stages that enable children to grow and learn from one another. We believe that every child is capable of excellence. Educating is about finding the key to unlocking that excellence and letting it grow in a school that nurtures individualized learning styles.

Bozeman Summit School is a Full Member School of the American Montessori Society (www.amshq.org), and all lead teachers hold Montessori credentials for the classroom level(s) they are teaching. As a result of these high standards, teachers strive to offer a carefully planned and individualized curriculum in a supportive environment that promotes strong moral character, self-confidence, respect and academic excellence.
