APPLICATION FEE

A non-refundable **\$75 application fee** must accompany all registration applications for an applicant to be considered as a prospective student.

TUITION DEPOSITS

Elementary program requires a two-month, non-refundable tuition deposit in order for a student to be considered as registered. The deposit will be applied to April and May's tuition of the registered school year. **All deposits are non-refundable.**

Early childhood program requires a one-month, non-refundable tuition deposit for a student to be considered as registered. The deposit will be applied to May's tuition of the registered school year. **All deposits are non-refundable.**

TUITION AND BILLING

Tuition is based on the child's enrollment status, and rates may change from year to year. Billing occurs according to the frequency selected on your TUITION CONTRACT. For more information about tuition rates and payment options, please consult the current TUITION CONTRACT.

FINANCIAL AID AND DISCOUNTS

Financial Aid informational packets may be obtained by contacting the office. The deadline to submit a financial aid application is March 15 for the coming school year.

A 5% sibling discount is available on tuition fees for each additional sibling from a family. Discount is applied to younger siblings.

DAILY SCHEDULE AND AFTERCARE

School hours are Monday through Friday from 8:15 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. The drop-off window is from 8:15-8:30 a.m. and students who arrive after 8:45 a.m. will be considered tardy. Pick-up is from 3:15-3:30 p.m. and students not picked up by 3:30 p.m. will be moved to aftercare. Half-day students should be picked up at 12:00 p.m. **Thank you for making a commitment to drop off and pick up your children on time.**

An aftercare program is available from 3:30-5:30 p.m. Monday – Friday. Aftercare is billed at the rate of \$7.00 per hour and in whole-hour increments. Any child not picked up by 3:30 p.m. will be moved to aftercare.

COMMITMENTS

Bozeman Summit School has annual commitments for salaries and operating cost. Parents/Guardians are responsible for tuition and other fees regardless of illness or vacations and enrollment is for the full school year. **A thirty-day written notice is required before withdrawing a child from the school or the following month’s tuition will be charged.**
